Course Information

- The GCE Ordinary Level (GCE O Level) examination is an internationally recognised examination set by the Ministry of Education, Singapore and University of Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicate, United Kingdom.
- Students enrolled for this course will take the examination as a private candidate.
- Students need to take 5 subjects (for polytechnic entry) or
 6 subjects (for junior college entry) for O-Level examinations.

Course Requirements

Students enrolling must

- Have completed 8 years of formal education or middle school / lower secondary education.
- Be at least 15 years old on Jan 1st of the year of examination.
- Have a pass in Lower Secondary English (in student's respective school) or IELTS
 4.5 or equivalent or pass INSPIRE's internal English entry test.
- Be a Singaporean or Singapore PR.
- Or hold a Dependant's Pass or Long-Term Visit Pass that is valid for the entire duration of the course if you are a foreign student.
- Not be a foreign student holding a student pass.
- Note: MOE approval is required for SC aged 16 or below in the year of application,
 and have not completed the GCE N-level or O-level.



Course Schedule

- Jan 5 to Nov 4 2026
- Ongoing intake till May 4 2026. Late entry fees apply from 5 Feb 2026 and admission will be considered on a case by case basis.
- Classes are ongoing throughout the year except for public holidays and stated school holidays. There is no term break except for study breaks before exams.
- Classes are generally conducted on Mondays to Fridays from 9am to 12pm with an hour lunch break and 1pm to 3pm.
- Full-time: 3 hours x 5 days x 10 months.

 Total contact hours: 460h.
- Part-time: 2 hours x 3 days x 10 months.
 Total contact hours: 220h.

Course Delivery

- The average teacher to student ratio is **1:9-19**.
- Face-to-face and online classes.



Exams / Assessments

Internal Assessments

- English and Mathematics placement tests, mid-year test and prelim exams in August - September
- Progress report will be only be given for students who take <u>a minimum of 4</u>
 <u>subjects</u> under Student-PEI contract and award for good progress.

External Examination

The Singapore-Cambridge General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level)
 Examination in October – November.

• Results are released usually in January the following year of the examination.

 Students have to sit for the Singapore-Cambridge General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) Examination in order to complete the O level course.

Refund Policy

Cooling Period

- New students are given a cooling period of SEVEN working days from the signing of the PEI-Student Contract.
- A student is able to withdraw from the course with a submission of a written notice within these 7 working days, even if the course commencement date has passed.
- The student will be entitled to the maximum refund amount as stated in the PEI-Student Contract.
- After the expiry of the 7-day cooling off period, the refund policy below will apply for any withdrawal upon receipt of a written notice of cancellation.

Course Withdrawal or Subject Change

- All Withdrawal and Subject Change applications have to be done in person and by submitting hard copy of the withdrawal form.
- All withdrawal forms have to be signed by Student and/or Parent / Guardian (for Student below 21 years old).
- Submit the Course Withdrawal Form or Subject Change Form at least ONE calendar month
 prior to the intended withdrawal or change date.
- Administrative fees apply.

 Subsequent instalment payments may be waived or adjusted only if withdrawal or subject change request is made at least ONE calendar month before the next instalment is due.

NS Deferment^

- INSPIRE may assist male students to apply for NS deferment. Approval is subject to MINDEF's discretion.
- Students need to enrol for minimum of 4 subjects to be eligible.
- Administrative fees apply.

Concession Card^

 All Singaporean students aged 20 years and below are eligible to apply for Transitlink concession card. Upon approval students can enjoy concessionary travel for the duration of the course.

[^] Students who withdraw from the course pre-maturely will have their Transitlink concession card or NS deferment cancelled within 7 days as they are no longer studying at the centre.
